AN ORDINANCE STANDARDIZING THE SALARIES OF ALL OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE NEW PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY EQUIVALENT TO THAT OF A 1ST CLASS PROVINCE, OTHER-WISE KNOWN AS THE "SALARY STANDARDIZATION ORDINANCE OF THE PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Zamboanga Sibugay in session assembled:

- Section 1.* - Section 5.2 of Local Budget Circular No. 64 dated January 22, 1997 states as follows: In accordance with Section 8 of Executive Order 389, flexibility is given each LGU to set its own schedule for the implementation of the final phase of salary increases authorized herein depending on its financial capability.
- Section 2.* - Adoption of Salary Schedule - Section 8.1 of LBC No. 64 states that LGU's lower than special cities and first class provinces and cities, may adopt the salary schedule for higher class LGU's subject to the conditions/limitations enumerated under LBC No. 56 dated January 25, 1995.
- Section 3.* - Standardization of Salaries - While the province of Zamboanga Sibugay is classified only as a second class province, former employees of the mother province who availed of their privileged pursuant to Section 52 of R.A. 8973 to transfer and work in the new province have been enjoying a salary scale of a first class province, the mother province being so; and while, further, there can be no diminution of their salaries as a result of their transfer, therefore, there is a need to standardized the salaries of all the employees of Zamboanga Sibugay equivalent to that of a first class province;
- Section 4.* - Repealing Clause - All ordinances, resolution or laws of local effect not in consonance hereto are hereby modified, superseded or repealed accordingly.
- Section 5.* - Separability Clause - Any section or provision of this ordinance which may be declared unlawful or unconstitutional shall not affect the other sections or provisions thereof.

Section 6. - Effectivity - This ordinance shall take effect starting noon time of June 30, 2001 and upon its approval by the Provincial Governor.
