AN ORDINANCE CONVERTING THE IPIL DISTRICT HOSPITAL INTO ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY PROVINCIAL HOSPITAL AND DEFINING ITS OBJECTIVES AND GENERAL FUNCTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Zamboanga Sibugay in session assembled:

Section 1. - Title – This ordinance shall be known and thereafter be referred to as an ordinance “ CONVERTING OF IPIL DISTRICT HOSPITAL INTO ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY HOSPITAL ORDINANCE 2001.”

Section 2. – Introduction and Justifications – The Ipil District Hospital (IDH) has been in operation for the last twenty seven (27) years with inadequate health services for the reasons that it is a primarily 25 bed hospital with limited personnel, facilities and budgetary requirements. For all these years this hospital failed to deliver the expected health services. Perhaps its devolution to the Province of Zamboanga del Sur has contributed to its present predicaments.

Section 3. – The conversion of the Ipil District Hospital into a provincial hospital speaks well for a much improved health services under the new Province of Zamboanga Sibugay. The moment it is converted there will be bigger budget, medical equipments and medical specialists can be hired, and facilities will be much improved including its building. The entire set up for health care services will enable hospital personnel to accommodate more seriously ill patients and emergencies rather than referring them to bigger hospital.

Section 4. Objectives – The primary objectives of the Zamboanga Sibugay Provincial Hospital shall be :

4.1 To establish of a continuous, effective, and sustainable health care services in its catchment areas.

4.2 To serve as a training center for medical, paramedical and rural health workers to deliver the services more effectively and efficiently.

4.3 To extend outreach medical services to remote areas and to the island towns of the province.

4.4 To fulfill its vision and mission for a healthy and progressive citizenry as a sensitive index of a healthy and dynamic community or nation.

Section 5 – General Functions – The Zamboanga Sibugay Provincial Hospital shall be responsible in the implementation of an effective, efficient, and sustainable health care services. It promotes and sustain the health of its citizenry in order to enjoy life to the fullest and to be socially and economically productive in the pursuit of the ultimate goals of the government and the governed.

Section 6 - The Conversion Process – The Ipil District Hospital is a 25-bed capacity primary hospital with only about 46 manpower, four medical officers, six (6) nurses and four (4) nursing attendants which are tasked to render directly to health care services, serving its catchment area comprising the municipalities of Siay, Kabasalan, Naga, Titay, Tungawan, RT Lim and Ipil.

Whereas, if this hospital is converted into a Provincial Hospital, the existing Ipil District Hospital personnel will be augmented with full complement of personnel in accordance with the plantilla of personnel or staffing pattern for provincial hospital promulgated by the Department of Health or to adopt for the time being, subject to amendments, the existing staffing pattern and personnel schedule of the Zamboanga del Sur Provincial Hospital with its 50-bed capacity.

Section 7 - Composition - To carry out the objectives and functions stated above, the staffing pattern and schedule of personnel, MOOE, and other aspects of its budget may be adopted as a basis for its composition and could be amended from time to time subject to the availability of funds and recommendations from the hospital officials themselves.

Section 8 - Statement of duties and Responsibilities :

Section 10. Repealing Clause - All ordinances, resolutions or laws of local application and effect inconsistent hereto are hereby modified, superseded, and repealed accordingly.

Section 11. Separability Clause - If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision hereof shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid,

other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 12. Effectivity - This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
